**Angela Sung** has been named senior vice president of management services and government affairs for the **Real Estate Board of New York (REBNY)**.

Sung will be responsible for the commercial and residential management division and all related issues, including building code and real property regulatory issues. She will also take the lead on federal issues that impact on New York City real estate.

Sung, who is the former Deputy Chief of Staff to the Deputy Mayor of Economic Development Robert Lieber, will replace Marolyn Davenport who is retiring.

Sung will be leading the effort to improve communication and procedures between the private sector and the city's various agencies that regulate construction in our city.

She will coordinate the industry's continued emphasis towards a greener New York. Federal issues that currently demand her attention include proposed changes to the carried interest rules, needed reform of the Foreign Investment in Real Property Tax Act



and working with our city and state leaders to insure New York receives its fair share of federal dollars.

Prior to working for the Bloomberg administration, Ms. Sung worked as a Clinical Research Associate within the pharmaceutical industry including Abbott Laboratories, Sankyo Pharma Development, and Knoll Pharmaceuticals.
