



## REBNY Residential Broker and Salesperson Members In Need Fund Application

Selection Criteria:

1. Applicant must be or have been a licensed broker or salesperson active in the residential sales and/or residential rental industry for two years and a member in good standing of the Real Estate Board of New York for the past two years or at least the two years prior to the onset of the hardship. Exceptions may be made for retired applicants who were members of REBNY for at least ten years.
2. Applicant must apply in writing explaining their extraordinary illness or crisis and how this grant will help to resolve their current situation. In addition, applicant must explain all avenues previously pursued or presently being pursued, accompanied by appropriate documentation.
3. A manager of applicant's firm must provide a letter in support of applicant's request.
4. The amount of the grant will be the decision of the Committee, but will not exceed \$10,000 for any one applicant in any one grant or multiple grants.
5. All names and company affiliation of applicant will be kept confidential from the selection committee.
6. No current REBNY Governor, Director of the Residential Brokerage Division, or member of the selection committee is eligible to receive a grant.

The selection committee will consist of at least 3 members of the Residential Deal of the Year Awards & Gala Committee, with at least one member also serving as a Board of Director of the Residential Brokerage Division.
